

Spring Funding Round Up 2026

General/Core Costs/Miscellaneous

Leathersellers Foundation: The foundation operates two grant programmes for UK registered charities:

Small Grants Programme – one-off grants for small projects.

Main Grants Programme – targeted funding rounds, with grants available towards core costs to support charities working within the focus area of the active round.

Deadline 30th April.

Schroder Charity Trust: Grants are available for charities following two objectives: education and employment; enhancing the wellbeing and life outcomes. **Deadline 30th April.**

Caremark Community Care Fund: Small grants to support grassroots community projects that improve quality of life and strengthen local communities. The fund supports practical, community-led initiatives, such as improving shared spaces, providing equipment, or enhancing local services, with a focus on delivering meaningful and lasting impact. **Deadline 31st May.**

Postcode Local Trust – West of England: Unrestricted grants are available for registered charities, community interest companies, and community benefit societies based and working in the west of England whose main activities address the current themes of the Trust (arts, poverty, mental health, inequality). **Deadline 2nd June.**

Chrysalis Trust: A small number of grants for UK registered charities with projects that are less popular and harder to fund that focus on the trust's priorities of relieving poverty and disability and providing access to shelter, education, healthcare and water. **Deadline 15th June.**

Veolia Environment Trust: Grants for projects that make improvements to community facilities and the natural environment that are located near a qualifying Veolia site. **Deadline 25th June.**

Britford Bridge Trust: Discretionary grants to charities involved in the prevention or relief of poverty; the advancement of education; the advancement of health or the saving of lives; and the advancement of the arts, culture, heritage or science. **Deadline 30th June.**

Severn Trent Community Fund – Core Costs: Grants to not-for-profit organisations to cover core costs for groups finding it hard to maintain their activities, to help them to continue delivering their vital services to local communities. **Deadline 30th June.**

Wolfson Foundation: Discretionary funding of capital infrastructure in the fields of science and medicine, heritage, arts and humanities, education, and health and disability. **Deadline 1st July.**

Hardship and Poverty

Screwfix Foundation: Grants for projects that improve, fix, and repair buildings, homes and facilities specifically used by people in need. **Deadline 10th May.**

B&Q Foundation Home Improvement Grants: One off grants for essential home improvements for people in need. **Deadline 15th May.**

Help the Homeless Grant Scheme: Grants for capital projects to charities working to assist homeless people to rebuild their lives and return to the community. **Deadline 20th May and 20th June.**

B&Q Foundation: For charities working to improve the lives of people in need by supporting projects that make homes safe, welcoming, and comfortable. Grants are for essential home improvements and home starter kits. **Deadline 22nd May.**

LandAid – Young Futures Fund: Funding to organisations supporting young people who are at risk of or experiencing homelessness. **Deadline 22nd May.**

Leeds Building Society: This funding is intended to support projects to improve the health, wellbeing and financial literacy of people who are experiencing homelessness. **Deadline 1st June.**

Yorkshire Building Society Charitable Foundation - Small Change Big Difference Fund: The fund aims to alleviate poverty and improve health/save lives, particularly for those living in areas of deprivation. **Deadline 30th June.**

Health, Social Care, Wellbeing

Music for All – Community Project Funding: For projects that are seeking to bring music to their communities. **Deadline 7th May.**

Pink Ribbon Foundation: Grants for breast cancer charities that assist people affected by breast cancer and organisations that work on breast cancer research and prevention. **Deadline 31st May.**

Heart Research UK – Healthy Heart Grants: Funding new projects in small local communities that work with adults and that actively promote heart health or reduce the risk of heart disease through primary or secondary prevention. **Deadline 3rd June.**

Ulverscroft Foundation: The Foundation supports charities, community interest groups and social groups in the UK and worldwide with projects that help visually impaired people. **Deadline 15th June.**

Hospital Saturday Fund: Grants of up to £10,000 to registered health charities such as hospitals, hospices and medical organisations for medical projects, care, research or support of medical training taking place in the United Kingdom. **Deadline 16th June.**

Environment and Energy

Asda Foundation - Local Community Spaces Fund: Grants for charitable groups to repair, renovate and develop local community spaces to ensure continued delivery of vital activities and services, including addressing loneliness and social isolation. **Deadline 28th April.**

Green Heat Network Fund: Capital grant funding to help new and existing heat networks move to low and zero carbon technologies, such as heat pumps, solar and geothermal energy. **Deadline 1st May.**

Heat Network Efficiency Scheme: Grants for organisations operating across the public, private and third sectors in England and Wales to upgrade existing heat networks to reduce emissions and energy costs for households. **Deadline 22nd May.**

Material Focus – Electricals Recycling Fund: Grants to support recycling, reuse or repair organisations that expand and trial ways to make it easier to fix, donate or recycle unwanted electricals. **Deadline 31st May.**

Bupa Foundation Green Community Grants: For practical projects which help with both people and planet health. **Deadline 30th June.**

Education, Children and Young People

Triangle Trust 1949 Fund: Grants to support young people with criminal convictions or young people at high risk of offending for the first time. For 2026 the focus is specifically on young women and girls. **Deadline 21st May.**

Sainsbury Family Charitable Trusts - JJ Charitable Trust Literacy Small Grants Scheme: Awarding £5,000–£20,000 for projects tackling literacy, particularly for children with learning difficulties like dyslexia. **Deadline 3rd June.**

Toy Trust: Grants for registered charities undertaking projects to support disadvantaged and disabled children who are under 13 years of age within the UK and abroad. **Deadline 15th June.**

Educational Opportunity Foundation: Grants for UK registered charities to advance educational opportunities for vulnerable or deprived children and young people in the UK and around the world. **Deadline 22nd June.**

Adamson Trust: Grants for voluntary and community organisations and charities to help with the cost of holidays or respite breaks for disabled children (aged 3 to 17 years) with physical, mental, or emotional impairments. **Deadline 30th June.**

Magdalen Hospital Trust: One-off grants of £2000 are available for small charities working with vulnerable children and young people especially those at risk of sexual and other forms of exploitation. **Deadline 30th June.**

Scott Bader Commonwealth Global Charity Fund: Grants for charities to fund environmental and educational projects and which help young or disadvantaged people in communities worldwide. **Deadline 30th June.**

Gender, Race, Migration and Social Justice

Older People

W.G. Edwards Charitable Foundation: Grants up to £1500 to UK-based charities that can demonstrate how they are making the lives of people over the age of 65 years better. **Deadline 5th June.**

Business, Digital Skills and Employment

The Different Foundation - AI for All: Grants and mentorship for small charities to use inclusive AI. **Deadline 30th April.**

Goldsmiths Foundation: Grants for charities and housing associations that focus on vocational skills and technical training in the creative industries in the UK. **Deadline 11th May.**

WCIT Charity: Grants to deliver IT projects and activities that support the themes of education, inclusion, IT for charities, and understanding of IT. **Deadline 20th May.**

DPO Centre – Charity and Community Fund: Grants for not-for-profit organisations support a range of data protection advice and consultancy services. **Deadline 31st May.**

Churches and Heritage

ChurchCare – Grants for Paintings: Grants are available for Anglican parish churches in England for the conservation of paintings and wall paintings. **Deadline 1st June.**

ChurchCare – Grants for Bells: Grants are available for Anglican parish churches in England to fund the conservation of bells and bell frames. **Deadline 20th June.**

Ouseley Church Music Trust: Grants are available for the promotion and maintenance to a high standard of choral services. **Deadline 30th June.**

Sports and Activities

Dan Maskell Tennis Trust: The Trust offers small grants to help disabled people to play tennis through the purchase of wheelchairs, tennis equipment and grants for coaching. **Deadline 10th May.**

Rowing Foundation: Grants for equipment that will support the participation of young people and disabled people in rowing. **Deadline 25th May.**

Barclays Community Sport Fund: Grants for not-for-profit organisations operating in an area of high deprivation in the UK to make football, cricket, or tennis more accessible to women and girls. **Deadline 27th May.**

Cycling UK – Big Bike Revival: Grants are available for voluntary groups, social enterprises, and other not-for-profit organisations to deliver cycling projects and activities across England for people who do not normally cycle. **Deadline 1st June.**

Veterans

Veterans Foundation – Salary Grants: Provides up to £25,000 per year (max £75,000 over three years) to charitable organizations supporting veterans and their families. **Deadline 30th June.**

Veterans Foundation – Standard Grants: Provides funding between £5,001 and £30,000 for charities and not-for-profit organizations supporting veterans, serving personnel, and their families across the UK. **Deadline 30th June.**
